THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Purchase of Wool Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Purchase of Wool Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 3rd day of July, 1946.

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the words "and delivered to a wool-store in accordance with Regulation 9 hereof before the end of the 1945-46 season".

3. Regulations 9 and 10 of the principal regulations are hereby revoked.
