

# THE PESTICIDES (VERTEBRATE PEST CONTROL) REGULATIONS 1983, AMENDMENT NO. 2

# THE HON. M. K. MOORE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 53 of the Pesticides Act 1979, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice of the Minister of Agriculture tendered on the recommendation of the Pesticides Board and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Pesticides (Vertebrate Pest Control) Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Pesticides (Vertebrate Pest Control) Regulations 1983\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- **2. Examinations**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 6, and substituting the following regulation:

- "6. (1) Every candidate for a licence in respect of the use and application of a controlled pesticide shall sit an examination consisting of one paper relating to the candidate's knowledge of—
  - "(a) Part V of the Act; and
  - "(b) These regulations; and
  - "(c) The controlled pesticide.
  - "(2) In the paper, 75 percent shall be the pass mark.
- "(3) The Board shall, on the request of a candidate, supply the candidate with such material as may be reasonably necessary to enable the candidate to prepare for the examination.
- "(4) Any examination under this regulation may be oral or written as the Board may determine."
- **3. Fees**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 11 (as amended by regulation 2 of the Pesticides (Vertebrate Pest Control) Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following regulation:
  - "11. (1) Every applicant for a licence shall pay to the Board a fee of \$70.
- "(2) Every applicant for a variation of any of the terms of a licence or of any condition attaching to a licence (excluding the omission from, but including the addition to, a licence of the name of any controlled pesticide) shall pay to the Board a fee of \$70."
- 4. New form substituted for applications for licences—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking form 1 (as amended by regulation 2 (4) of the Pesticides (Vertebrate Pest Control) Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the form set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 5. Saving—(1) Notwithstanding the revocation of regulation 6 of the principal regulations, and the substitution of the regulation 6 set out in regulation 2 of these regulations, any candidate for a licence in respect of a controlled pesticide who, before the date of commencement of these regulations, has passed one paper of the examinations referred to in regulation 6 (1) of the principal regulations (as so revoked) but who has failed the other paper referred to in that regulation shall be entitled, before the 1st day of April 1987, instead of sitting the examination referred to in regulation 6 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of these regulations), to sit a paper corresponding to the paper that the candidate would have been required to sit but for the revocation by these regulations of regulation 6 of the principal regulations.
- (2) In any paper referred to in subclause (1) of this regulation, 75 percent shall be the passmark.
- **6. Revocation**—The Pesticides (Vertebrate Pest Control) Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Pesticides (Vertebrate Pest Control) Regulations 1983.

Regulation 2 provides that the examination that candidates for a licence to use controlled pesticides are required to sit shall consist of only 1 paper, instead of 2 papers. The subject-matter of the examination will not, however, be affected.

Regulation 3-

- (a) Increases from \$40 to \$70 the fee payable on an application for a licence to apply or otherwise use a controlled pesticide under Part V of the Pesticides Act 1979; and
- (b) Increases from \$40 to \$70 the fee payable on an application for a variation of the terms or conditions of any such licence.

Regulation 4 makes various minor amendments to the application form to be used by candidates for a licence to use controlled pesticides. The most significant amendment is that a candidate is now required to state whether he or she currently holds a licence to use controlled pesticides.

Regulation 5 is a saving provision in respect of candidates for a licence to use controlled pesticides who have already passed, before the commencement of these regulations, 1 of the 2 papers constituting the examination that such persons are required to sit. Such a candidate shall be entitled, before 1 April 1987, to sit only the remaining paper instead of being required to sit the whole examination referred to in regulation 2 of these regulations.
