**THE PATRIOTIC PURPOSES EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of
December, 1939.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Patriotic Purposes Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Patriotic Purposes Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is further amended by revoking clause (5) (as enacted by Regulation 5 of the Patriotic Purposes Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1), and inserting, next after clause (4), the following clause :—

“(4A) Each member of the Board shall be paid the sum of £1 5s. as a travelling-allowance for personal expenses for each complete day on which he is absent from his headquarters in connection with the business of the Board. For any portion of a day the rate shall be one twenty-fourth of the full daily rate for each hour’s absence. When a member leaves and returns to his usual headquarters on the same day, actual and reasonable expenses only shall be paid.”

4. The principal regulations are amended by adding next after Regulation 36 (as enacted by Regulation 7 of the Patriotic Purposes Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1), the following regulation :—

“REGULATION 37.—EXEMPTION FROM GIFT DUTY.

“No gift duty shall be payable on a gift of any property for any patriotic purpose within the meaning of the Patriotic Purposes Emergency Regulations 1939, and such gift shall not be included in the dutiable estate of the donor, notwithstanding that he may die within three years after having made the gift.”
