**THE PATRIOTIC PURPOSES EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 5.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 25th day of
June, 1941.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Patriotic Purposes Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 5.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Patriotic Purposes Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following clause :—

“(5) At any time during his term of office the Chairman of any Provincial Council may, by writing under his hand, request the Provincial Council to release him from his duties as Chairman of the Council. The Provincial Council and the Chairman aforesaid shall then decide upon a suitable person to act as Chairman of the Council for the term for which the retiring Chairman would have continued to hold office under these regulations, and any person agreed upon by resolution of the Provincial Council and the approval in writing of the retiring Chairman shall thereupon become Chairman of the Council and shall for the term aforesaid be a member of the Council.”
