ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 61A (1) of the Meat Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Poultry Processing Houses Licensing Commencement Order 1978.

2. Interpretation—In this order, “the Act” means the Meat Act 1964.

3. Commencement of Part IVA of the Act in respect of poultry processing houses—Part IVA of the Act (as inserted by section 12 of the Meat Amendment Act 1968) shall, in respect of the licensing of premises for the slaughter, processing, or canning of poultry intended for sale for human consumption, come into force on the 1st day of July 1980.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The order provides that Part IVA of the Meat Act 1964 (which relates to the licensing of premises on which poultry intended for sale for human consumption is slaughtered, processed, or canned) is to come into force on 1 July 1980.
