PURSUANT to section 61M of the Meat Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Processing Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Poultry Processing Regulations 1978\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Commencement date of principal regulations extended**—Regulation 1 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “1980”, and substituting the expression “1981”.
