HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 61M of the Meat Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Processing Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Poultry Processing Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Commencement date of principal regulations extended—

(1) Regulation 1 (2) of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Poultry Processing Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the expression “1981”, and substituting the expression “1982”.

(2) The Poultry Processing Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
