Pursuant to section 190 of the Personal Property Securities Act 1999, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Personal Property Securities Amendment Regulations 2004.
- (2) In these regulations, the Personal Property Securities Regulations 2001¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 July 2004.

3 Fees

Regulation 21 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

- “(1) The fees set out below are payable for the following matters:
- “(a) for registering a financing statement under section 141 of the Act, \$3:
 - “(b) for renewing the registration of a financing statement under section 154 of the Act, \$5:
 - “(c) for a search of the register, \$1:
 - “(d) for sending a verification statement by post, \$10:
 - “(e) for a certified copy of a registered financing statement, \$25.”

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 2004, amend the Personal Property Securities Regulations 2001. The amendments—

- reduce the fee for registering a financing statement from \$5 to \$3; and
- reduce the fee for a search of the register by registration number from \$1.50 to \$1; and
- reduce the fee for a search of the register by all other criteria from \$3 to \$1.

The fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.
