## THE PLUMBERS REGULATIONS, 1931, AMENDMENT NO. 2.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Plumbers Registration Act, 1912, and all other powers enabling in that behalf.

Date on which the regulations were made : 10th day of June, 1937. Date of notification in Gazette: 22nd day of July, 1937.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Plumbers Regulations, 1931, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Plumbers Regulations, 1931.\*

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 30th day of June, 1938.

4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by the addition to section (A) thereof of the following clause :-

"8. Knowledge of the principles applicable to the bending, jointing, welding, and brazing of metal pipes.<sup>3</sup>

5. Section (B) of the First Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and the following substituted therefor :-

"(B) Practical test in workmanship. This part will be of an advanced character and will be such as to show that the candidate can execute in a satisfactory manner within a reasonable time the following practical plumbing work :--

"(a) Lead burning, lead-pipe bending, sheet-lead bossing, jointwiping.

"(b) Copper and other metal pipe bending, jointing, welding, and brazing.

"No springs are allowed for pipe-bending, but heat is allowed, and any means of heat must be supplied by the candidate. In wiping solder joints to lead pipes heat must be applied by means of hot metal, and by that means alone. Other methods of applying heat to wipe joints will disqualify a candidate."
