REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Plumbers Regulations 1931, Amendment No. 8.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Plumbers Regulations 1931* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. Part I of the Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to the list of boroughs, including cities, named therein the borough named in the Schedule hereto.
