HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the provisions of the Poisons Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 6.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1947.
- 4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations, as substituted by Regulation 7 of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4, is further amended by adding to clause (3) the following words: "or except in accordance with an order for group supply of pharmaceutical requirements in bulk to a licensed hospital issued by a medical practitioner under the provisions of the drug tariff as defined by clause 2 of the Social Security (Pharmaceutical Supplies) Regulations 1941† as amended by clause 2 of the Social Security (Pharmaceutical Supplies) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 4‡".
