**THE POISONS (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 1937,  
AMENDMENT NO. 6**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the provisions of the Poisons Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 6.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1947.

4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations, as substituted by Regulation 7 of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4, is further amended by adding to clause (3) the following words : " or except in accordance with an order for group supply of pharmaceutical requirements in bulk to a licensed hospital issued by a medical practitioner under the provisions of the drug tariff as defined by clause 2 of the Social Security (Pharmaceutical Supplies) Regulations 1941† as amended by clause 2 of the Social Security (Pharmaceutical Supplies) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 4‡ ".
