**THE POISONS (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 1937,
AMENDMENT NO. 7**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Poisons Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, on the recommendation of the Pharmacy Board of New Zealand, so far as such recommendation is required by law, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 7.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1949.

4. Regulation 8 of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4, is hereby amended by revoking the expression " clause (3) ", and substituting therefor the expression " clause (2) ".

5. The First Schedule to the Poisons Act, 1934 (as replaced by clause (2) of Regulation 2 of the principal regulations and amended by Regulation 8 of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4 (as amended by the preceding Regulation 4 hereof), and by Regulation 5 of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 5), is hereby further amended as follows :—

(a) By removing therefrom the substances named and specified in paragraphs 32 and 35 thereof, and revoking the said paragraphs :

(b) By adding thereto the substances or classes of substances named and specified in the following paragraphs :—

" 35. (a) 6 - morpholino - 4 - 4 - diphenyl - heptane - 3 - one ;
(b) its salts, including the hydrochloride known as ' Heptalgin ' and also as ' C.B. 11 ' .

“ 36. All those preparations or substances named in the Second Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs Regulations 1928*, as amended by the Dangerous Drugs Amendment Regulations 1934† and the Dangerous Drugs Amendment Regulations 1949, No. 2‡.”

6. The Fourth Schedule to the Poisons Act, 1934 (as replaced by clause (5) of Regulation 2 of the principal regulations and amended by Regulation 6 of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 5), is hereby further amended as follows :—

- (a) By removing therefrom the substance named and specified in the paragraph appearing therein next following the words “ purely industrial purpose ”, and revoking such paragraph :
- (b) By adding thereto, next following the said words “ purely industrial purpose ”, the substance named and specified in the following paragraph :—

“ Preparations of 2, 2-bis (p-chlorophenyl) -1, 1, 1-trichlorethane, also known as dichlor-diphenyl-trichlorethane and popularly known by the abbreviation DDT, containing not less than 1 part per centum of dichlor-diphenyl-trichlorethane.”

7. Clause (1) of Regulation 4 of the principal regulations (as replaced by Regulation 7 of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4, and as amended by Regulation 4 of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 6) is hereby further amended by revoking the following paragraph :—

“ Group X—(a) Ethyl 1 - methyl - 4 - phenylpiperidine - 4 - carboxylate ; (b) its salts ”,

and substituting therefor the following paragraph :—

“ Group X—(a) 6 - morpholino - 4 - 4 - diphenyl - heptane - 3 - one ; (b) its salts, including the hydrochloride known as ‘ Heptalgin ’ and also as ‘ C.B. 11 ’.”

8. Regulation 6 of the Poisons (General) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 5, is hereby revoked.
