## THE PRISONS REGULATIONS 1940.

## GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 12th day of June, 1940.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Prisons Act, 1908 (as amended by section 16 of the Statute Law Amendment Act, 1917), the Prisons Amendment Act, 1912, the Prisons Amendment Act, 1919, and the Crimes Amendment Act, 1910 (as amended by the Crimes Amendment Act, 1920), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Prisons Regulations 1940, and these regulations and the Prisons Regulations 1925 to 1937\* may together be cited as the Prisons Regulations 1925 to 1940.
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the 27th day of July, 1940.
- **3.** Regulations 403, 404, 405, and 408 of the Prisons Regulations 1925, as inserted by the Prisons Regulations 1932, and Regulations 406 and 407 of the Prisons Regulations 1925, as inserted by the Prisons Regulations 1937, are hereby revoked.
