THE PHARMACY REGULATIONS 1944, AMENDMENT NO. 3

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 11th day of
February, 1948

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Pharmacy Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in accordance with recommendations made by the Pharmacy Board of New Zealand and transmitted by the Board to the Minister of Health, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Pharmacy Regulations 1944, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Pharmacy Regulations 1944* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March, 1948.

3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Item 8 thereof, and substituting the following item :—

“ 8. For enrolment of a manager of a pharmacy . . . 10s. Od.”
