THE PHARMACY REGULATIONS 1944, AMENDMENT NO. 9

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 23rd day of December 1959

Present:
HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Pharmacy Act 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in accordance with recommendations made by the Pharmacy Board of New Zealand and transmitted by the Board to the Minister of Health, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Pharmacy Regulations 1944, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Pharmacy Regulations 1944* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 19, and substituting the following regulation:

"19. The annual practising fee payable to the Society by every chemist shall be the sum of £3 3s."
