ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of July 1963

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Plumbers Registration Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Plumbers Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Plumbers Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Regulations 1 and 2 of these regulations shall come into force on the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, and regulation 3 of these regulations shall come into force on the day six months after that date.

2. The Counties of Masterton and Mauriceville are hereby declared to be districts within which, on and after the expiration of six months from the date of the coming into force of this regulation, all sanitary plumbing work shall be done by registered plumbers.

3. (1) Part I of the Third Schedule to the principal regulations (as set out in the Second Schedule to the Plumbers Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 6) is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the letter (b) which appears after the word "Masterton".

(2) Part V of the Third Schedule to the principal regulations (as set out in the Second Schedule to the Plumbers Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 6) is hereby consequentially amended by inserting, after the word "Manukau", the words "Masterton" and "Mauriceville".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of these regulations is that, on and after the expiration of six months from the date of the notification of these regulations in the *Gazette*, all sanitary plumbing in the Counties of Masterton and Mauriceville must be done by registered plumbers.
