PURSUANT to sections 114 and 115 of the Patents Act 1953, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Patents Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 14, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Patents Regulations 1954* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1992.
