



THE PETROLEUM REGULATIONS 1978, AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 19th day of December 1988

Present:

THE HON. M. K. MOORE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Petroleum Act 1937, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Petroleum Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Petroleum Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fees inclusive of goods and services tax—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 3, the following regulation:

“3A. The fees specified in the First Schedule to these regulations (but not the deposit or bond payable on the grant of a licence) are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.”

3. Increasing fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule, and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The Petroleum Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.
