**THE PHYSIOTHERAPY REGULATIONS 1979,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 15th day of March 1982

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. D. MACINTYRE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 31 (2) (e) of the Physiotherapy Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Physiotherapy Regulations 1979, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Physiotherapy Regulations 1979* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fees for admission to State Examination—Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclauses:

“(1) The fee for admission to the State Examination for any student physiotherapist sitting the full examination shall be \$40.

“(1A) The fee for admission to the State Examination for any student physiotherapist whom the Board has directed need not be examined in any subject or subjects shall be \$25.”

3. Fee for annual practising certificate—(1) Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (4) the expression “\$8”, and substituting the expression “\$16”.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 17 (4) of the principal regulations (as amended by subclause (1) of this regulation), the fee for the issue of a practising certificate in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of March 1982 shall be \$8.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fee for admission to the State Examination payable by student physiotherapists sitting the full examination from \$35 to \$40.

The fee payable by student physiotherapists who have been credited with passing part of the examination is reduced from \$35 to \$25.

The fee payable by a physiotherapist for an annual practising certificate is increased from \$8 to \$16, although the fee payable for a practising certificate in respect of the current year (which ends with 31 March 1982) remains at \$8.
