ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of June 1982

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to section 18 of the Passports Act 1980, His Excellency the
Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the
Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Passports Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Passports Regulations 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 2nd day of July 1982.

2. New scale of fees substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(iii) Addition of a new photograph of the holder	
Provided that no fee shall be payable in respect of any endorsement required by the Minister under regulation 5 of these regulations

6. For a Certificate of Identity	20.00"
