ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 18 of the Passports Act 1980, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Passport Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Passport Regulations 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1986.
- 2. New scale of fees substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Passport Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **3. Revocation**—The Passports Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 1 are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 August 1986, increase fees payable for various matters under the Passports Act 1980. A higher fee is to be charged in most cases if the application is made outside New Zealand. Fees, additional to those set out in the Passport Regulations 1981, are prescribed in respect of—

- (a) The renewal of a passport under regulation 4 (2) of the Passport Regulations 1981:
- (b) The urgent issue, renewal, or endorsement of any passport (other than an endorsement required by the Minister under regulation 5 of the Passport Regulations 1981) or the urgent issue of a certificate of identity outside normal office hours. This fee is payable in addition to the normal fee.

The regulations also clarify that a fee is payable for an endorsement of a passport on a change of name due to marriage or reversion to a maiden or former name.
