THE PSYCHOLOGISTS REGULATIONS 1983

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of October 1983

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 43 (a) of the Psychologists Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister of Health given after consultation with the Psychologists Board, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Psychologists Regulations 1983.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—In these regulations the term "the Act" means the Psychologists Act 1981.

3. Fees—(1) The fee payable in respect of an application for registration under section 15 of the Act shall be \$20.

(2) The fee payable for the issue of a certificate of registration under section 18 of the Act shall be \$5.

(3) The fee payable for the issue of a certificate of temporary registration under section 23 of the Act shall be \$10.

(4) The fee for the issue of an annual practising certificate under section 25 of the Act shall be \$20.

(6) The fee for supplying to a psychologist any document for the purpose of seeking registration overseas shall be \$10.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
