

# THE PESTICIDES REGULATIONS 1983, AMENDMENT NO. 5

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 76 of the Pesticides Act 1979, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Pesticides Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Pesticides Regulations 1983\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Application fee for registration—(1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Pesticides Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$350", and substituting the expression "\$1,500".
- (2) Regulation 2 of the Pesticides Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 4 is hereby consequentially revoked.

- **3. Annual registration fee**—Regulation 3A of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Pesticides Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended—
  - (a) By omitting from subclause (1) the word "April", and substituting the word "July":
  - (b) By omitting from subclause (2), and also from subclause (4), the words "30th day of April", and substituting in each case the words "31st day of July".
- **4.** Amount of goods and services tax excluded—The fee fixed by these regulations is exclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Pesticides Regulations 1983.

Regulation 2 increases from \$350 to \$1,500 the application fee for the registration of a pesticide. The fee is exclusive of goods and services tax.

Regulation 3 changes the beginning of the registration year from 1 April to 1 July, in accordance with the Government accounting year.
