



THE PSYCHOLOGISTS REGULATIONS 1996

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 29th day of January 1996

Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 43 (a) of the Psychologists Act 1981, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister of Health given after consultation with the Psychologists Board, hereby makes the following order.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Psychologists Regulations 1996.

(2) Subject to regulation 5 (2) of these regulations, these regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—In these regulations “the Act” means the Psychologists Act 1981.

3. Fees—(1) The fee payable in respect of an application for registration under section 15 of the Act shall be \$450.00.

(2) The fee for the issue of a certificate of registration under section 18 of the Act shall be \$30.00.

(3) The fee for the issue of a certificate of temporary registration under section 23 of the Act shall be \$450.00.

(4) Subject to regulation 5 (2) of these regulations, the fee for the issue of an annual practising certificate under section 25 of the Act shall be \$303.75.

(5) The fee for the issue of a copy of a certificate of registration shall be \$30.00.

(6) The fee for supplying to a psychologist any document for the purpose of seeking registration overseas shall be \$43.00.

4. Fees inclusive of goods and services tax—The fees fixed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

5. Revocation and saving—(1) The Psychologists Regulations 1994* are hereby consequentially revoked.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 3(4) of these regulations, the fee payable for an annual practising certificate issued in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of March 1996 shall be \$240.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe the fees payable under the Psychologists Act 1981.

The only change is an increase in the fee payable for the issue of an annual practising certificate. The new fee of \$303.75 will first have effect in respect of practising certificates issued in respect of the year beginning on 1 April 1996. The current fee of \$240 will continue to apply in respect of practising certificates issued in respect of the year ending on 31 March 1996.
