### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 9th day of February 1998

PURSUANT to section 43 (a) of the Psychologists Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister of Health given after consultation with the Psychologists Board, makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Psychologists (Fees) Regulations 1998.

(2) These regulations come into force on 13 March 1998.

**2. Interpretation**—In these regulations, “the Act” means the Psychologists Act 1981.

**3. Fees**—(1) The fee payable in respect of an application for registration under section 15 of the Act is \$450.00.

(2) The fee for the issue of a certificate of registration under section 18 of the Act is \$30.00.

(3) The fee for the issue of a certificate of temporary registration under section 23 of the Act is \$450.00.

(4) Subject to regulation 5 (2), the fee for the issue of an annual practising certificate under section 25 of the Act is \$455.00.

(5) The fee for the issue of a copy of a certificate of registration is \$30.00.

(6) The fee for supplying to a psychologist any document for the purpose of seeking registration overseas is \$43.00.

**4. Fees inclusive of goods and services tax**—The fees fixed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax.

**5. Revocation and saving**—(1) The Psychologists Regulations 1996\* are revoked.

(2) Despite regulation 3 (4), the fee payable for an annual practising certificate issued in respect of the year ending on 31 March 1998 is \$303.75.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 13 March 1998, prescribe the fees payable under the Psychologists Act 1981. They replace the Psychologists Regulations 1996.

The only substantive change is that the fee for an annual practising certificate is increased to \$455.00. The old fee of \$303.75 continues to apply for licences in respect of the year ending on 31 March 1998.
