**THE PHARMACY REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1955,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 2nd day of June 1965

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Pharmacy Act 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Pharmacy Registration Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Pharmacy Registration Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 8, and substituting the following regulation:

“8. There shall be paid by each applicant a fee of £5 5s. in respect of the registration of a pharmacy and a fee of £5 5s. in respect of each renewal of registration.”
