Pursuant to the Pharmacy Act 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Pharmacy Registration Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Pharmacy Registration Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 8, and substituting the following regulation:
- "8. There shall be paid by each applicant a fee of £5 5s. in respect of the registration of a pharmacy and a fee of £5 5s. in respect of each renewal of registration."
