

# THE PHARMACY REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1972, AMENDMENT NO. 3

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 57 (i) of the Pharmacy Act 1970, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Pharmacy Registration Regulations 1972, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Pharmacy Registration Regulations 1972\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1982.
- 2. Pharmacy registration fees—(1) Regulation 7 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Pharmacy Registration Regulations 1972, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$50" in both places where it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression "\$75".
- (2) The Pharmacy Registration Regulations 1972, Amendment No. 2

are hereby consequentially revoked.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The regulations increase from \$50 to \$75 the annual registration fee for pharmacies.
