**THE POULTRY RUNS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1934,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 31st day of May 1961

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Poultry Runs Registration Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Runs Registration Regulations 1934, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Poultry Runs Registration Regulations 1934\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 4, and substituting the following regulation:

“4. (1) Every receipt for the payment of a registration fee under the said Act shall be in a form provided by the Board.

“(2) Every receipt in that form purporting to be issued by or on behalf of the Board shall, in the absence of proof to the contrary, be sufficient evidence of the registration of the poultry run occupied by the person named in the receipt for the registration year stated therein, and it shall not be necessary to issue a certificate of registration to that person.”

3. The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Form No. 2.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations simplify the procedure involved in the issue of receipts for the payment of registration fees under the Poultry Runs Registration Act 1933.
