## THE PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES **DETERMINATION 1980, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

PURSUANT to section 16 of the Civil List Act 1979 and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination.

### DETERMINATION

1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal determination). (2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on

the 10th day of November 1980.

2. Salaries—The principal determination is hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by clause 2 of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to this determination.

3. Revocation—The Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 10 November 1980, increases by 15.7 percent those Parliamentary salaries which at 1 August 1980 did not exceed \$30,196 a year and by 12.5 percent those Parliamentary salaries which at that date exceeded that figure.

This determination is made under section 20 (2) of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 following a general adjustment to salaries in the State services. The effective date of that general adjustment is 10 November 1980. This determination does not effect any change in Parliamentary allowances.
