

**THE PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES  
DETERMINATION 1980, AMENDMENT NO. 4**

PURSUANT to section 16 of the Civil List Act 1979 and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination.

**DETERMINATION**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This determination may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal determination).

(2) This determination shall come into force on the 11th day of June 1981.

**2. Salaries**—The principal determination is hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by clause 2 of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to this determination.

**3. Revocation**—The Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980, Amendment No. 3 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This determination, which comes into force on 11 June 1981, increases Parliamentary salaries by 5 percent.

This determination (which results from the order made by the Arbitration Court on 21 May 1981 under the Economic Stabilisation (Cost-of-Living Increase) Regulations 1980) is made as required by section 23 of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 (as substituted by section 6 of the Remuneration Act Repeal Act 1980).

This determination does not effect any change in Parliamentary allowances.
