## THE PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES DETERMINATION 1980, AMENDMENT NO. 4

PURSUANT to section 16 of the Civil List Act 1979 and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination.

## **DETERMINATION**

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal determination).
- (2) This determination shall come into force on the 11th day of June 1981.
- 2. Salaries—The principal determination is hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by clause 2 of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to this determination.
- 3. Revocation—The Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1980, Amendment No. 3 is hereby consequentially revoked.
