**THE PUBLIC SERVICE AMENDING REGULATIONS 1939.**

In pursuance and exercise of the authority conferred on him by the Public Service Act, 1912, the Public Service Commissioner doth, subject to the approval of the Governor-General in Council, hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Service Amending Regulations 1939.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made under the Public Service Act, 1912, on the 31st day of March, 1913* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making and approval hereof.

4. Regulation 150 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted :—

“ Temporary workmen or employees required by any Department shall be engaged and discharged by the holders for the time being of offices the holders of which as such the Commissioner may from time to time appoint for that purpose.”
