



THE PUBLIC SERVICE AMENDING REGULATIONS 1943

IN pursuance and exercise of the authority conferred on him by the Public Service Act, 1912, the Public Service Commissioner doth, subject to the approval of the Governor-General in Council, hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Service Amending Regulations 1943.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made under the Public Service Act, 1912, on the 31st day of March, 1913* (hereinafter called the principal regulations), and shall come into force on the 29th day of November, 1943, or as soon thereafter as the approval of the Governor-General in Council thereto is given.

3. Clause (1) of Regulation 8E of the principal regulations (as enacted by the Public Service Amending Regulations 1942) is revoked and the following substituted:—

“(1) Subject to clause (4) of this regulation, payment to officers of the Professional and Clerical Divisions for overtime work for which extra payment may be made pursuant to Regulation 8B hereof shall be made at the following rates:—

“For work which is exclusive of work on the days set out in clause (4) of this regulation and which is in excess of forty hours a week, at one and a half times the hourly rate of payment of the officer concerned, with a minimum rate of 2s. 3d. an hour and a maximum rate of 6s. 9d. an hour:

“Provided that in any special case the Commissioner may fix a lower or higher overtime rate.”
