**THE PUBLIC SERVICE AMENDING REGULATIONS 1948
(NO. 2)**

PURSUANT to the Public Service Act, 1912, the Public Service Commission doth, subject to the approval of the Governor-General in Council, hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Service Amending Regulations 1948 (No. 2).

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the regulations made under the Public Service Act, 1912, on the 31st day of March, 1913* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of February, 1948.

4. Regulations 8c of the principal regulations, as substituted by Regulation 4 of the Public Service Amending Regulations 1946†, and as amended by Regulation 5 of the Public Service Amending Regulations 1947‡, is hereby amended by revoking the symbols "6s. 9d." and "7s. 6d." in paragraphs (a) and (b) of clause (1) respectively, and substituting therefor the symbols "7s." and "8s. 6d." respectively.

5. (1) Regulation 109 of the principal regulations, as enacted by Regulation 8 of the Public Service Amending Regulations 1948§, is hereby revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—

"109. (1) All employees to whom this part of these regulations applies may be paid travelling-allowances for personal expenses while travelling within the Dominion of New Zealand in accordance with the following scale of rates:—

"(a) Employees receiving a salary not exceeding £485 per annum	20 0
"(b) Employees receiving a salary exceeding £485 but not exceeding £585 per annum	22 6
"(c) Employees receiving a salary exceeding £585 but not exceeding £1,025 per annum	25 0
"(d) Employees receiving a salary exceeding £1,025 per annum	27 6

“(2) All employees to whom this part of these regulations applies may be paid travelling-allowances for personal expenses while absent from New Zealand at rates to be determined from time to time by the Commission.

“(3) Whenever the Commission is satisfied that a lower travelling-allowance than the scale allowance should suffice, or a higher travelling-allowance than the scale allowance is warranted, the scale allowance may be reduced or increased, as the case may be.”

(2) Regulation 8 of the Public Service Amending Regulations 1948,* and clause 6 of Regulation 110 of the principal regulations as heretofore from time to time amended are hereby revoked.

6. Clause (1) of Regulation 111B of the principal regulations, as substituted by Regulation 9 of the Public Service Amending Regulations 1948,* is hereby amended by revoking the symbols “12s. 6d.”, “15s.”, and “17s. 6d.”, and substituting therefor the symbols “15s.”, “17s. 6d.”, and “20s.” respectively.
