ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 1st day of July 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Post-Primary Schools Accounts Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Post-Primary Schools Accounts Regulations 1950\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 10, the following regulation:

"10A. Out of any credit balance for the time being in the appropriation account kept by it in respect of a school hostel or school hostels under its control, a governing body may establish a reserve fund for hostel buildings, and the money credited to that fund shall be deposited in a separate bank account or otherwise specially invested."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the principal regulations so as to enable the governing body of a post-primary school that conducts a hostel to establish a reserve fund for hostel buildings.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.
