PURSUANT to the Private Savings Banks Act 1964, His Excellency the
Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the
Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Private Savings Banks (Com-
mencement of Business) Order 1964.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1964.

2. Each savings bank company specified in the Schedule to this order
is hereby authorised to commence to carry on a private savings bank.
