**THE PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES DETERMINATION
1982**

PURSUANT to section 16 of the Civil List Act 1979 and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination.

DETERMINATION

1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries Determination 1982.

(2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on the 10th day of November 1981.

2. Salaries—The salaries payable pursuant to section 16 of the Civil List Act 1979 shall be those set out in the Schedule to this determination.

3. Revocations—The following determinations are hereby revoked, namely:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 10 November 1981, increases Parliamentary salaries by 9.2 percent.

This determination is made under section 20 (2) of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 following a like general adjustment to salaries in the State services. The effective date of that general adjustment is also 10 November 1981.

This determination does not effect any change in Parliamentary allowances.
