THE PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES (ANNUITY) DETERMINATION 1986

PURSUANT to section 22 of the Civil List Act 1979 and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination.

DETERMINATION

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries (Annuity) Determination 1986.
- (2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of December 1984.
- 2. Annuity for former Prime Minister—The annuity payable under section 22 (1) (a) of the Civil List Act 1979 to a person who has held the office of Prime Minister for a period or periods amounting in all to not less than 2 years shall be at the yearly rate of \$4,000 for each complete year of the total period for which that person held that office or at the yearly rate of \$20,000, whichever is the less.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This determination increases the annuity payable under section 7 (1) (a) of the Civil List Act 1979 to a person who has held the office of Prime Minister for a period or periods amounting in all to not less than 2 years.

The rate of that annuity was last fixed in 1973. Under clause 18B (1) of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Order 1970 (as inserted by clause 5 of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Order 1970, Amendment No. 3 (S.R. 1973/280), and as continued in force by section 26 (3) of the Civil List Act 1979), that annuity is paid at the yearly rate of \$1,000 for each complete year of the total period for which the person held the office of Prime Minister or at the yearly rate of \$5,000, whichever is the less.

Under this determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 1 December 1984, that annuity is to be paid at the yearly rate of \$4,000 for each complete year of that total period or at the yearly rate of \$20,000, whichever is the less.
