**THE PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES (ANNUITY)  
DETERMINATION 1986**

---

PURSUANT to section 22 of the Civil List Act 1979 and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination.

---

**DETERMINATION**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This determination may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries (Annuity) Determination 1986.

(2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of December 1984.

**2. Annuity for former Prime Minister**—The annuity payable under section 22 (1) (a) of the Civil List Act 1979 to a person who has held the office of Prime Minister for a period or periods amounting in all to not less than 2 years shall be at the yearly rate of \$4,000 for each complete year of the total period for which that person held that office or at the yearly rate of \$20,000, whichever is the less.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This determination increases the annuity payable under section 7 (1) (a) of the Civil List Act 1979 to a person who has held the office of Prime Minister for a period or periods amounting in all to not less than 2 years.

The rate of that annuity was last fixed in 1973. Under clause 18B (1) of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Order 1970 (as inserted by clause 5 of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Order 1970, Amendment No. 3 (S.R. 1973/280), and as continued in force by section 26 (3) of the Civil List Act 1979), that annuity is paid at the yearly rate of \$1,000 for each complete year of the total period for which the person held the office of Prime Minister or at the yearly rate of \$5,000, whichever is the less.

Under this determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 1 December 1984, that annuity is to be paid at the yearly rate of \$4,000 for each complete year of that total period or at the yearly rate of \$20,000, whichever is the less.
