THE POST-PRIMARY SCHOOL GRANTS REGULATIONS 1946

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 20th day of March, 1946

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Post-primary School Grants Regulations 1946.
- (2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1946.
- (3) The regulations specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby revoked to the extent indicated therein.

APPLICATION

2. These regulations shall apply to every secondary school, combined school, and technical school, and to every technical class recognized under the Education Act, 1914.

GRANTS FOR INCIDENTAL PURPOSES AND ADMINISTRATION

- 3. (1) There shall be paid to every controlling authority having immediate control of any school or technical class to which these regulations apply an annual grant of an amount equal to 20 per cent. of the gross amount paid by that controlling authority for the salaries of principals and teachers in respect of their employment in all such schools or classes controlled by that authority computed as provided in the next succeeding subclause.
- (2) The gross amount of the salaries of principals and teachers referred to in the last preceding subclause shall be the sum of all the salaries payable during the preceding year by the controlling authority to the said principals and teachers (excluding any salary payable in respect of the management of a school hostel or to teachers employed in the lower department of any school).

- (3) In addition to the grant provided for under subclause (1) hereof, an additional annual grant of £250 shall be paid to every controlling authority of any school to which these regulations apply, whether or not the authority controls one or more of such schools.
- (4) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this clause, if the Minister is satisfied that by reason of special circumstances the grant computed in accordance with those provisions is insufficient in any case, he may authorize the making of an additional grant at a rate not exceeding £250 per annum. Any such authority given by the Minister may be limited in its application to a specific period or, if no period is specified, shall continue in force until it is revoked by the Minister.
- 4. The grant paid in accordance with the provisions of clause 3 hereof shall be expended only for purposes relating to the said schools or classes, and to the extent indicated in any case, as follows:—
 - (a) Office salaries; office expenses, including office furniture and equipment; printing; advertising; stationery; postages; telephone; rent; fuel; bank charges; and audit fees, not exceeding in all one-fourth of the total grant:

(b) Legal expenses:

(c) Furniture, fittings, books, apparatus, equipment, material (including in any case any charges for replacement, maintenance, or repair), and stationery, for use in the instruction of pupils or classes:

(d) Cleaning and sanitary services, heating, lighting, ventilation,

and water-supply:

(e) Maintenance and repair of buildings and improvement of school

 ${f grounds}$:

(f) Travelling allowances and expenses of teachers and pupils, for which the prior approval of the Director has been obtained:

(g) Hire of models for art classes:

- (h) Refund of reasonable expenses incurred by any applicant for appointment as a teacher in appearing before the controlling authority at its request:
- (i) Refund of reasonable expenses incurred by any teacher employed by the controlling authority in attending educational conferences or meetings, for which the prior approval of the Minister has been obtained.
- 5. If the Minister is satisfied that adequate provision has been made for all the purposes mentioned in the last preceding clause he may, on application being made to him, approve of the whole or any part of the balance of the grant provided for under clause 3 hereof being expended for any other suitable purpose.
