THE RIGHT HON, S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Post-primary School Grants Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Post-primary School Grants Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 5 of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 2 of the Post-primary School Grants Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 2, is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (k) of subclause (2), and substituting the following paragraphs:

(k) Expenses of breaking-up ceremonies and school prizes:

"Provided that the maximum amount which may be so expended shall be £35 for a school with a roll not exceeding 500 pupils on the 1st day of March in the year of the grant, which maximum shall be increased in the case of other schools by £15 for each additional complete 250 pupils (if any) and for the balance (if any) in excess of every complete 250 pupils on the roll of the school at that date:

"(1) Reasonable expenses incurred in the hire of a hall, under circumstances approved by the Director, for a school break-up

ceremony:

(2) The Post-primary School Grants Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 2, are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations alter the amount which the governing body of a secondary school may expend in connection with school prizes, breaking-up ceremonies, and the hire of halls for such ceremonies.
