**THE POST-PRIMARY SCHOOL GRANTS REGULATIONS 1957,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Post-primary School Grants Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Post-primary School Grants Regulations 1957\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Paragraph (a) of regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting the words “regulation 5”, and substituting the words “regulation 6”:

(b) By adding the following proviso:

“Provided that, where the Minister of Education considers that a technical school is providing technical classes or courses of a special or advanced character, he may require that the grant provided for under this paragraph shall not apply to that school; and in that case the governing body of the school shall be paid instead thereof a special grant for the general purposes of the school of an amount to be determined by the Minister of Education with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance, which grant shall be applicable in accordance with regulation 6 of these regulations, except that the amount of the grant applicable in accordance with subclause (1) of that regulation shall be determined by the Minister of Education with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance:”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations give a discretion to the Minister of Education with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance to fix the amount of the general purpose grant that is payable where a technical school is providing technical classes or courses of a special or advanced character.
