# THE PRIVATE SCHOOLS GRANTS REGULATIONS 1978, AMENDMENT NO. 1

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## **REGULATIONS**

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Private Schools Grants Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Private Schools Grants Regulations 1973\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- **2. Interpretation**—Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definitions of the terms "private school" and "State school", and inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following definitions:
  - "'Principal Act' means the Education Act 1964:

- "'Private school' means a primary school, secondary school, or special school providing special education, registered under section 186 of the principal Act:
- "'State school' means a school that is a State primary school, a secondary school, or a school established under section 98 (1) (a) of the principal Act to provide special education."
- **3. Special grants to private special schools**—Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "private primary schools", and substituting the words "private schools (other than secondary schools)".
- **4. Calculation of number of pupils on roll**—Regulation 12 (1) (a) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "primary schools", and substituting the words "schools other than secondary schools".

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

This amendment applies the principal regulations to private special schools. Previously they applied only to private primary and secondary schools.
