THE PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES INTERIM DETERMINATION 1988

PURSUANT to section 16 of the Civil List Act 1979 and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, and, in particular, to section 8 (2) of the Higher Salaries Commission Amendment Act 1988, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following interim determination (to which is appended an Explanatory Memorandum).

DETERMINATION

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries Interim Determination 1988.
- (2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1988.
- **2. Salaries**—The salaries payable pursuant to section 16 of the Civil List Act 1979 shall be those set out in the Schedule to this determination.
- **3. Consequential revocations**—Clause 2 of, and the First Schedule to, the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1987* are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This memorandum is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

- 1. This interim determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 1 April 1988, revises the salaries payable to members of the House of Representatives. It has been issued pursuant to section 8 (2) of the Higher Salaries Commission Amendment Act 1988, which provides that the Higher Salaries Commission may issue an interim determination with effect from 1 April 1988 to adjust the remuneration of any of the categories of persons who are covered by the principal Act. As required by the same section 8 (2) of the Amendment Act, the adjustments made are to be subsequently incorporated into a final determination which may have a term commencing on or after 1 April 1988.
- 2. The rates of allowances payable pursuant to section 16 of the Civil List Act 1979, as prescribed in the Second Schedule to the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1987, remain unchanged.
