**THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS 1950,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to the Public Service Act, 1912, the Public Service Commission, subject to the approval of the Governor-General, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Public Service Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Service Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1951.

2. Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) By omitting from subclause (2) the words “ Permanent Head ” where those words first occur, and substituting the words “ controlling officer ” :

(b) By inserting in subclause (2), before the words “ shall be responsible ”, the words “ the controlling officer ”.

3. Regulation 54 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “ Good Friday to the following Monday inclusive ”, and substituting the words “ Good Friday and Easter Monday ”.

4. Regulation 69 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) of subclause (1) the word “ two ”, and substituting the word “ seven ”.
