At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of July 1965

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the State Services Act 1962, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Public Service Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Service Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of August 1964.

2. Regulation 71 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, before the words "contributory service" at the third, fourth, and fifth places where they appear in subclause (3), and at the second, third, and fourth places where they appear in subclause (4), the words "actual or".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide that, subject to the qualifications expressed in the principal regulations, a contributor to the Superannuation Fund whose contributory or actual service at the age of 60 years does not exceed 40 years shall be required to relinquish office when either his contributory or actual service exceeds 40 years or when he attains the age of 65 whichever is the earlier.
