PURSUANT to the State Services Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Public Service Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Service Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1987.

(2) Part XI of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking regulations 66, 67, 68, and 70.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1987, amend the Public Service Regulations 1964 by revoking regulations 66, 67, and 68 (all of which are related to Government office accommodation) and regulation 70 (under which the Government Office Accommodation Board was established).

The revocations are consequential on the passing of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986, which removes from the State Services Commission, on 1 April 1987, its responsibility for the provision of suitable office accommodation for Departments of the Public Service.
