**THE PUBLIC SERVICE REMUNERATION ORDER 1938,
AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 20th day of
December, 1939.

Present :

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 10 of the Finance Act, 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Service Remuneration Order 1938, Amendment No. 1.

2. These amendments shall be read together with and form part of the Public Service Remuneration Order 1938.

3. These amendments shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1939.

4. The rates prescribed in the First Schedule of the Public Service Remuneration Order 1938 are amended by revoking the words—

“ (g) £215 per annum at the age of twenty-one years or over, on completion of six years’ permanent service ”,
and substituting the following words :—

“ (g) £230 per annum at the age of twenty-one years or over, on completion of six years’ permanent service ” ;

and by adding the following subclause :—

“ (h) £240 per annum at the age of twenty-one years or over, on completion of seven years’ permanent service, increasing to £245 per annum after one year at the rate of £240 per annum.”
